If you're HIV+ you'll probably have to deal with a whole load of complicated and distressing issues. These can range from anxiety about your health to worries about keeping up a healthy and fulfilling sex life.

There's nothing wrong with having lots of sex, or no sex at all. You don't have to give up things that give you pleasure, but you may decide to weigh up the pleasure and the risks involved. How safe, secure and happy you feel about the sex you're having can have a big effect on you're general well being. Unfortunately, it's almost certain that you'll face some prejudice and discrimination. Sometimes it can come from unexpected and unwelcome sources, and that includes other gay or bisexual men who are negative or who haven't been tested. There's still a lot of ignorance, and people can make some very strange,

illogical and hurtful assumptions about you.

HIV is a very personal subject. Having the chance to discuss your concerns may increase your own confidence so that you can make your own informed decisions and take control.

MESMAC continually works towards challenging the prejudice and discrimination against HIV+ people. It's hardly surprising if you're worried and confused about being HIV+. One of the ways of tackling this is to get information and learn more about the virus, your own sexual health or combination therapies.

MESMAC can offer you help with this, and also the opportunity to talk about concerns you may have about things like disclosure of your status, relationships, abuse, legal issues, illness, HIV drug therapies, harassment, housing and discrimination.

We distribute materials that look at various aspects of HIV/AIDS, and when we identify areas that aren't being addressed, we develop resources to cover them.

MESMAC can also put you in touch with other support groups and specialist HIV workers throughout the North East.
